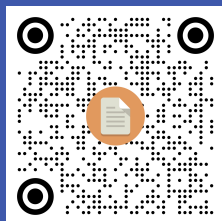

1. The authors are requested to submit manuscripts of their lecture/presentation and should make a written declaration that the paper is neither published nor communicated elsewhere for publication hitherto;

2. The manuscripts should be typed within a maximum of 3000 words in either MS-Word or Google Docs format;

3. The article should have a clear mention of title and subtitle (if any) in 14pt Bold Times New Roman font and should be center aligned;

4. Author affiliations and contact details should be mentioned clearly below the Title/Subtitle of the paper. Clear mention of corresponding authors should be there in case of a research paper written by more than one author;

5. The body of the manuscripts should adhere to the following pattern:

1 Heading (should be bold in 12pt Times New Roman font)

1.1 Subheadings (if any) (Should be bold in 11pt Times New Roman font)

All text under the headings/subheadings etc. should be in double spaced single column 11pt Times New Roman font and left aligned;

6. The reference and in-text citation should adhere to the APA 7th Edition (2020) guidelines. (A copy of the template of APA 7th edition is to be downloaded as a paper template with the LINK provided below);

7. All the pages of the paper should be numbered in Roman font starting from '1';

8. The full text paper with the abstract is to be submitted to the **email id dr.royavik@gmail.com** within 20 August, 2025.
